All scores are based on the student's SAT or PSAT score prior to beginning the Ivy Bound course. Where the student has not reported an SAT or PSAT score, the base is the score achieved on an actual released SAT taken under timed conditions early in the Ivy Bound course. This test is scored in the same way as the SAT and PSAT and has the same number of scored questions as the SAT. Where two or more scores have been reported prior to the start of the course, the reported base is the score closest to the start of the course. Where two or more scores have been reported after the conclusion of the Ivy Bound course, the increase is based on the better set of scores.

Unless the student AND parent have released to Ivy Bound the right to publicize their names and scores, each student is referred to by an internal identification number. All scores reported are based on an oral or written acknowledgement by Educational Testing Service ("ETS"). Under contract law and Privacy Act regulation, ETS is under no obligation to release scores. Ivy Bound strongly encourages post-class reporting, but cannot get reports if the student is unwilling.

(\*) refers to a student who has not allowed Ivy Bound to release information relating to his/her name.

(\*\*) refers to a student who has not allowed Ivy Bound to release information, for whom Ivy Bound has not received a score report.

A decimal after the class refers to the attendance of the student in that class, as a percentage of the required class sessions. Decimals are rounded up to the nearest tenth. No decimal assumes 95% to 100% attendance.
